

S.O.S. SERVING OUR SISTERS

Individuals who served in the U.S. military face a unique set of needs that often go unmet. The mental, physical, and military service needs of females who served often are very different from those of male veterans. S.O.S. provides a safe space for female veterans and survivors of MST to seek legal assistance and access resources vital to their financial and medical security and successful reintegration into civilian life.

In addition to the struggles faced by all veterans, female veterans experience military sexual trauma (MST) at a significantly higher rate than the general population. S.O.S. provides comprehensive, trauma-informed, free civil legal services to veterans and those who served currently residing in Broward County. These services are provided to any survivor of MST regardless of gender.

- VA and Social Security benefits, applications
- Name change
- Expungements
- Family law
- Consumer Rights
