How it Works

Coast to Coast Legal Aid of South Florida provides no cost legal services for residents of Broward County who qualify for services. Financial eligibility is based upon the income and assets of individuals in a household. In most cases, the income of a household cannot exceed 125% of the federal poverty level.

Legal aid intake workers will assist in completing an application and determine eligibility for services.

If a resident is 60 years of age or older, there are no financial eligibility guidelines for services.

Eligibility for services is also based upon whether a legal problem falls within the core practice areas.
