Decide in advance if you're going to:

- stay in your home
- go to an emergency shelter
- evacuate your home



If you evacuated, return home only when officials say it is safe, and stay out of any building that has water around it.



Have your "go bag" ready, with your phone, keys, wallet, and keep a cooler or icepack ready for your medication.



If you have property damage, take pictures and contact your landlord and/or insurance company as soon as possible.



Make copies of important documents like your homeowner's or renter's insurance policy and lease, and place them into a watertight bag.



Keep a car charger with you in case your electricity goes out, so that you can charge your phone.
